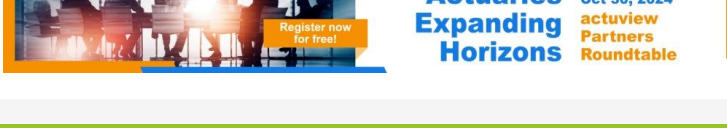




## Greetings

### The Power of Saying No: A Crucial Lesson based on my Career Journey

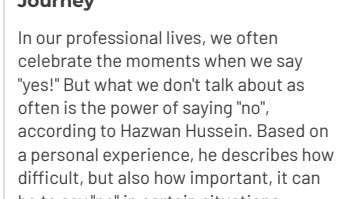
